VEPA – **VET Planner for Work Based Learning** - is a project realized in the framework of ERASMUS + programme, Key Action Cooperation for innovation and exchange of good practice.

Starting with the development of a “**Competences Profile**”, the project will elaborate a “**Guide to training the VET planners face to face**” an “**E-Course course for VET planners**” and an on-line tool for the “**Assessment for the VET planners**” in the WBL field.

PROJECT'S UPDATE

The second project meeting was held on the 11th and 12th of July in Pitesti (RO) at the AOA Arges premises. VEPA partners analyzed the answers that 150 VET planners gave to a questionnaire, developed specifically for the project, which aimed to identify their needs in order to define the tasks of the VET planner.

This activity has allowed to lay the foundations for developing the future tasks foreseen by the project, first of all the definition of the competences of the VET planner, divided into knowledge, skills and responsibility and autonomy. Another achievement was the creation of the “**Canvas for the face-to-face and e-training course**” that will be filled by each partner in the next 6 months. The meeting participants have the occasion to attend a study visit at Ronera company <https://www.ronera.ro/> to discuss about their strategy to welcome students applying the work-based learning (WBL) and helping them to acquire knowledge, skills and competences with direct application to the labour market

WHAT'S NEXT

The Consortium is now elaborating the **E-learning course** in accordance with the **ECVET system** which will explore the following areas: planning; managing; monitoring and collecting evidences; final assessment, validation and certification; networking with stakeholders; improving WBL experience. Also the Guide addressed to trainers of VET planners and to VET planners themselves will be concluded.
