VEPA - VET Planner for Work Based Learning -

is a project realized in the framework of the ERASMUS + programme, Key Action 2, Cooperation for innovation and exchange of good practice.

The project aims to setting up a modern training profile and a new professional model development for VET planners for increased efficacy of VET courses based on work-based learning experiences and enhanced cooperation between VET organisations, learners and businesses. A training course will support VET planners to manage a quality program that can provide the WBL learners with effective tools for the development of his/her employability.

Thanks to VEPA a "Competences Profile of the VET planner", a "Guide to training the VET planners face to face", an "E-Course course for VET planners" and an online tool for the "Assessment for the VET planners" in the WBL field will be made available.

PROJECT'S UPDATE

The project partners, despite the criticality of the moment, are continuing to work on the project deliverables. After having met in Valladolid (ES) last December, at the Infodef headquarters (www.infodef.es), for the third Project Meeting, they completed the pilot version of the Guide to training the VET planners face-to-face, the contents for the E-Course and the Assessment tool.

WHAT'S NEXT - THE PILOT PHASE

The pilot, an important moment for the verification of the effectiveness of the VEPA products, was planned to take place both face to face and remotely.
